Cell Phone Use

The use of cell phones will be permitted before and after school, during lunch period, and passing time. Cell phone usage will be permitted during class time at the teacher's discretion. Cell phone ringers must be set to the silent mode.

Any abuse or neglect of the Acceptable Use Policy may be subject to disciplinary action. The use of cell phones by students is a privilege and may be denied at any time.

Policy Clarifications

- This policy is extended to the possession and use of all portable electronic equipment (iPods, iPads, etc.).
- Students are extended the privilege of possessing and responsibly using portable electronic equipment on school grounds or at any school-related activity.
- Use of these electronic devices in the classroom or in any academic setting is at the discretion of the classroom teacher.
- All devices should be on *silent* mode at all times.
- Collection and/or distribution of material that is considered obscene, libelous, or harassing is prohibited not only by school policy but by state and federal law. This includes but is not limited to pictures, videos, texts, posts, and emails.
- The use of any portable electronic device capable of taking pictures, video, and/or transmitting data in locations where students and/or staff have a reasonable expectation of privacy is prohibited at all times. These locations include but are not limited to locker rooms and restrooms.
- Per District policy, use of these devices is not allowed while on the school bus.
