

Dismissal Success' Lesson Plans

'Dismissal Success' Lesson Plans

Learning Target: Students will be able to demonstrate how to dismiss in a safe, orderly and timely manner.

Begin lesson by telling students that the purpose of this dismissal lesson plan is for students to dismiss safely, orderly and timely.

RESPONSIBLE DISMISSAL BEHAVIOR

Students will be prepared to leave the classroom at dismissal time (textbooks, homework, personal items, etc.)
Students will follow appropriate hallway procedures to designated dismissal area.

Dismissal order:

Office Dismissal
Walkers/Little Bo Peep Dismissal
First Bus Dismissal
Late Bus Dismissal

Come in to the cafeteria on **voice level 0** and go to assigned table.
Be seated with grade level.
Hold all personal items or keep them immediately in front of you.
Maintain **voice level 1** while waiting for your bus.
When bus number is announced, line up on **voice level 0** ready to load the bus.
Keep hands, feet, and materials to yourself.
Safely load the bus and be seated at **voice level 1**.

Remind students of the different voice levels. You will model the proper procedure for 'Dismissal Success', making sure students follow hallway procedures during this process. Please practice this procedure with your class. We will have a designated time that the whole school will practice this dismissal procedure. Please continue to practice this daily for the first two weeks and after fall break, Thanksgiving break, Christmas break, spring break and any other extended break from school.

CONSEQUENCES FOR INFRACTIONS

Verbal reminder of appropriate practice/procedure
Verbal/nonverbal warning
Positive practice of procedure
Isolated seating
Pin moved for persistent infraction
Minor Discipline Referral form
Office referral-total insubordination or dangerous action

These consequences do not have to be implemented in the above order; you will use these consequences at your discretion. But persistent infractions should result in an immediate pin moved.

We want to make sure that we reward those students who show excellent behavior at dismissal time. Students will receive periodic recognition for positive dismissal behavior by being featured on morning announcements or receiving other special recognition.

It is our responsibility to serve as role models for these dismissal procedures.
