

ATTENTION PARENTS

If you have a child entering any grade or transferring to Marshall County Schools, please review the following health requirements. These must be met to comply with Kentucky’s state regulations. In addition, parents must provide a social security number, birth certificate, and a NEW immunization certificate for each child. The following summarizes the health requirements for school entry.

Three Hepatitis B vaccines 5. Two Varicella Vaccines (or documentation of having had the virus) 6. A complete physical exam on KY form 7. A complete eye exam by ophthalmologist or optometrist * 8. A complete dental exam ** 9. NEWER: Two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine (must be at least 6 months apart—if not already received) <p><i>**The dental exam/screening must be completed during the calendar year that the student starts kindergarten (e.g. if the student was 4 years old at time of exam/screening, but starting kindergarten the following fall, it would be accepted)</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis Vaccine (TDap) 2. First Dose of Meningococcal Vaccine 3. Second Dose of Varicella Vaccine (if not already received) 4. A complete physical exam on KY form 5. NEWER REQUIREMENT: Two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine (at least 6 months apart—if not already received) 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Second dose of Meningococcal vaccine (unless first dose was given after age 16, then only one is required) 2. NEWER REQUIREMENT: Two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine (at least 6 months apart—if not already received)

Medical and/or Religious Exemption Form must be completed if vaccines were not administered due to these reasons.
